

Building PITT from Source

- Follow the instructions for building PKIF v2 (<http://pkif.sourceforge.net/building-pkifv2.pdf>) to build PKIF and its dependencies, including xerces and xalan.
- Request a free version of LMX from <http://www.codalogic.com/lmx/buy.php>.
- Download free version 5.1 of the LMX runtime from <http://www.codalogic.com/lmx/download.php> and install to an appropriate location.
- Create the LMX_HOME environment variable and point it to <LMX Install Location> \supporting-software.
- Download the PITT source package and extract to an appropriate location.
- Open PkiInteropTestTool.sln and compile PITT.

Note: In order to run the PITT executable, the xerces, xalan, and LMX dlls must be available on the windows DLL search path. Typically it makes sense to copy these to the same directory as the PITT executable.
